

**VILLAGE OF CANASTOTA  
LOCAL LAW NO. B OF 2026**

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 216 OF THE CODE  
OF THE VILLAGE OF CANASTOTA TO DESIGNATE  
CERTAIN STREETS AND/OR PORTIONS OF STREETS IN  
THE VILLAGE AS PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES**

Be it enacted by the Trustees of the Village of Canastota as follows:

**SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE AND INTENT.**

The purpose of this Local Law is to designate certain streets and/or portions of streets in the Village of Canastota as parking prohibited at all times.

**SECTION 2. AUTHORITY.**

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the New York State Constitution and New York State Municipal Home Rule Law §10.

**SECTION 3. AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 216 OF THE VILLAGE OF CANASTOTA CODE.**

Chapter 216, Section 216-19 (“Parking prohibited at all times in certain locations”) of the Code of the Village of Canastota is hereby amended to add the following:

| <b>Name of Street</b> | <b>Side</b> | <b>Location</b>                                                  |
|-----------------------|-------------|------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Delano Avenue         | East        | From First Street to Second Street                               |
| East Hickory Street   | North       | From South Peterboro Street easterly to High Street              |
| First Street          | North       | From High Street to Delano Avenue                                |
| First Street          | South       | From High Street to the Driveway of South Side Elementary School |
| James Street          | Both        | From South Peterboro Street westerly a distance of 45 feet       |
| Second Street         | North       | From High Street to Delano Avenue                                |

**SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.**

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part of this Chapter shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part thereof, directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Local Law shall take effect upon enactment by the Village Board of Trustees.
